City Council, District 6

Voters in this north Wichita district are fortunate to have two well-qualified candidates who care deeply about this community. **Janet Miller** is the best choice because of her standout leadership on city boards and task forces and her track record of working with others to get things done.

Miller is a member of the District 6 Advisory Board and the 21st Street Business Association and a board member of neighborhood associa-

tions. She also is president of the Wichita Park Board and led efforts to develop a new comprehensive park plan. She also served as vice chairwoman of the Taskforce to End Chronic Homelessness, which resulted in the city and county governments making commitments to combat this difficult challenge.
